

## Speaker Guidelines and Agreement

1. The Education sessions will cover information and topics requested by The Strategic Enterprise Risk Management Council and agreed to by me.
2. I agree to fully comply with all program-related deadlines provided to me by RIMS, including but not limited to handouts, audio and visual recording requests, biographical information, etc.
3. During my presentation, I will not engage in any type of promotional marketing or selling of any product or service. I will also refrain from distributing any collateral (e.g., flyers, brochures -) in the session room. I acknowledge that if I engage in unauthorized commercial activities at the Conference, I may forfeit future speaking opportunities.
4. I agree to notify RIMS senior event program manager immediately if an emergency should prevent me from meeting my obligation as a content leader.
5. I grant to RIMS a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, non-exclusive, sublicensable, transferable, royalty-free, fully paid-up license to use, reproduce and distribute my presentation (including all handouts and slide decks) in any way in the future, with appropriate attribution to me. I understand that this license does not change the fact that I retain copyright ownership of my presentation and does not prohibit me from using my presentation in any way or from allowing others to use it.

While using AI tools, Speaker may not enter any RIMS or third-party confidential, trade secret, or other personal or proprietary information into a prompt for an AI Tool. Speakers shall comply with all RIMS policies and guidelines on use of AI tools.
8. I represent and warrant that the content of my presentation is of my own creation, and that I have not plagiarized or otherwise used third party content without proper attribution and authorization. I hereby indemnify RIMS, its officers, directors, employees and agents, from and against any third-party claims of copyright infringement. I further represent and warrant that the information included in my presentation is factually accurate. I hereby indemnify RIMS, its officers, directors, employees, and agents from and against any third-party claims arising out of alleged or actual factual inaccuracies in my presentation. If RIMS learns that I have included factually inaccurate information in my presentation slide deck or made factually inaccurate statements during my presentation, RIMS reserves the right to ban me from speaking at future RIMS events.

9. I authorize RIMS to use my name, likeness, photograph, and biographical data in connection with the use and promotion of the program.
10. I acknowledge that RIMS may use artificial intelligence (AI) to develop transcripts, summaries and word clouds of my session. I further acknowledge that these AI-generated documents may contain errors, and I hereby release RIMS from any and all claims I might have for such errors.
11. **The policy clearly prohibits** speakers and their affiliated companies from filming sessions, which helps protect intellectual property, attendee privacy, and content integrity.
12. I acknowledge that RIMS may cancel my presentation at any time without liability or further obligation if RIMS determines, at its sole discretion, that my presentation does not meet RIMS ERM quality standards.
13. “If you can do it on Zoom, don’t do it in the room.” RIMS education program should be immersive, interactive, and engage the audience through active audience participation. If the content could simply be a one-sided webinar, consider updating the presentation and format.
14. **Travel:** RIMS ERM Conference does not reimburse session speakers for expenses related to travel or entertainment, nor do we provide fees or honorariums.
15. **Registration:** All speakers participating in the ERM Conference must register for the full conference. All accepted speakers—both members and non-members—are offered a **preferred full-conference registration rate of \$450**, which provides access to the entire event.  
  
**Note:** There is **no option** for speakers to attend only for the day or for the session in which they are presenting, and one-day or session-only registrations are not available to speakers.
